All lunch and snacks should be **NUT FREE** (look for the school safe logo)



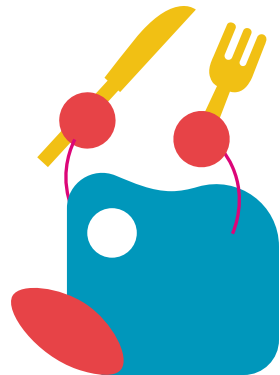
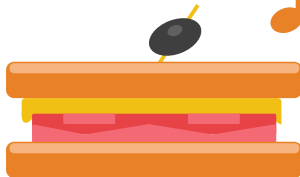
Please try to **minimize wrappers** and other **packaging** where possible



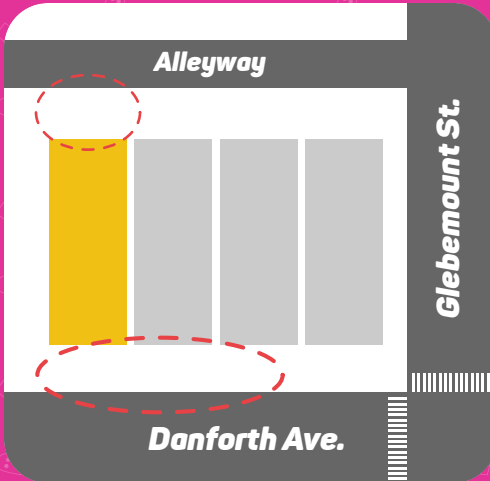
We have a mini-fridge and microwave that kids can use if they want

Stuffies or toys that could be in-class distractions (unless we request it), muddy or dirty shoes without a clean set for indoor use, and please no food with nuts!!





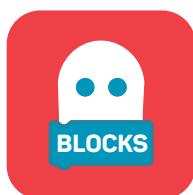
# BRINGING A LAPTOP?

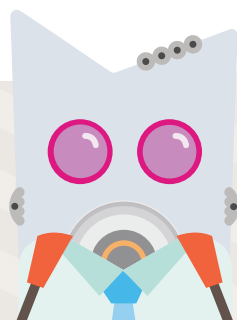
